








# **SAT Comparison Class of 2018**





#### **Terra Nova Results**



Alpha Omega Academy had students ranging from Kindergarten through 10<sup>th</sup> grade complete the Terra Nova Test. The Terra Nova test is a series of standardized achievement tests used in the United States designed to assess K-12 student achievement in reading, language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, vocabulary, spelling, and other areas.


Terra Nova is a norm-reference nationally standardized Achievement test. Nationally standardized means that the test was administered to students across the country.

The results of the Terra Nova scores from school year 2017–2018 show that Alpha Omega Academy is above the 60<sup>th</sup> percentile in the nation in all subjects tested on Kindergarten through 10<sup>th</sup> grade.



## **Grammar Wing Opening**

The new 9,000 square-foot facility was constructed in just four months and includes seven new classrooms for pre-kindergarten, kindergarten and first grade. It was made possible through the help of contributions from parents, faculty and staff and members from the community.

"It was a group decision on behalf of the staff, parents and board. This school was 420 students last year, and we feel that this school is a ministry to the community, and we want to continue that," AOA School Board chair Chris deMilliano said. "We had to decide to grow and growing is tough. There is the physical part about building this in four months, but it's also tough to staff. There was a lot of prayer that went into it, just amazing help from the staff and Mr. (Paul Davidhizar) and our board. These guys all sacrificed, and a lot of people sacrificed on the basis of money, but they all sacrificed their time. Getting people out here and getting things done, it was just amazing how quickly we got things accomplished."


