










Demographics

The rising STAR of Texas








SAT Comparison Class of 2019

The Terra Nova test is a series of standardized achievement tests used in the United States designed to assess K-12 student achievement in reading, language arts, mathematics, science, social studies, vocabulary, spelling, and other areas.


Terra Nova is a norm-reference nationally standardized Achievement test. Nationally standardized means that the test was administered to students across the country.


