PIZZA FRIDAY LUNCH ORDERS - There is one staff position that we are still searching for, and we are reaching out to the AOA community for help. We have advertised for a kitchen manager since March and have been unable to find someone to fill the position. If you know of anyone that might be interested in managing the kitchen, please encourage them to apply on our website.

As of now, the plan is to continue to have pizza on Fridays. Students will need to bring a lunch to school Mon-Thur, also Friday unless ordering pizza. We will not allow DoorDash, Uber Eats, or any other food delivery to school. Pizza ordering is available on our website now for the entire school year. Pizza lunch orders for August 18th and 25th will close at noon on Tuesday, August 15th.

AOA AFTER SCHOOL CARE 2023-24 – After school care begins daily at dismissal and ends promptly at 5:30 p.m. The fee is \$165 per month for the 1st child and \$40 per month for each additional child. The fee will be automatically drafted from your FACTS account on the 20th of each month, August through May. There will be an additional fee of \$1 per minute for every minute past 5:30 p.m. Please fill out and return the attached form with payment to secure your registration.

<u>Tryouts:</u> August 16th & 17th, 7am-8:40am at the AOA Gym. Team assignments will be posted in the gym for practice on August 18th.

<u>Attire:</u> Players will wear AOA school PE uniforms or any AOA Volleyball t-shirt to practice. In addition, kneepads are needed to be purchased (black is preferred but not mandatory). Court shoes must be worn. Hair must be pulled back-preferably with hairband-NO barrettes. Water bottles.

<u>Uniforms:</u> AOA will provide a game jersey. Players are to provide court shoes, shorts, knee pads and game socks. Game socks must be either solid navy, white, black or gray and without design (manufacture logo is permissible). Playing Time:

When athletes attend practices:

C Team: all players will receive playing time each match.

B Team: an attempt for all players to play each match will be made but not guaranteed. A team is the most competitive of the three. Therefore, parents and players understand that players on the A team are NOT guaranteed any playing time. It is understood that there will be matches that some players will not play.

<u>Match Schedules:</u> Most matches will occur on Mondays and Thursdays OR Tuesdays and Thursdays. Because not all schools have a C Team, their season is shorter. If there are enough for two C Teams, the two teams will alternate competing and when home matches occur with no opponent, they will compete with one another. A & B Teams may participate in weekend tournaments during the season.

<u>Physicals/Athletic fee:</u> All Players are required to have physicals and pay an athletic fee.
